

GOOD SAMARITAN'S CLUB, CUBA



\$25 can provide:

- A nutritious meal and the Gospel to seven children.
- A week of VBS and meals for seven children in the summer.
- A week-long program and meals for 13 children and their fathers.
- A week-long program and meals for five teenagers and their fathers.

\$50 can provide:

- A nutritious meal and the gospel to 14 children.
- A week of VBS and meals for 14 children in the summer.
- A week-long program and meals for 26 children and their fathers.
- A week-long program and meals for 10 teenagers and their fathers.

\$75 can provide:

- Safe drinking water to a family in our program.
- One month of weekly meals and the gospel for three children at a new feeding program.

\$100 can provide:

- A nutritious meal and the gospel to 28 children.
- A week of VBS and meals for 28 children in the summer.
- A week-long program and meals for 52 children and their fathers.
- A week-long program and meals for 20 teenagers and their fathers.

\$120 can provide:

Monthly employment for two families maintaining one of our farm projects in Cuba.

\$175 can provide:

- Monthly volunteer stipend for five volunteers who organize and cook the meals.
- Monthly support for three fulltime Cuban missionaries in the Pastoring the Lambs program.

\$250 can provide:

Access to safe drinking water for four families.

\$500 can provide:

Access to safe drinking water for eight families.

\$900 can provide:

Christmas service and celebration with a meal for all in attendance.

\$1,000 can provide:

A nutritious meal and the Gospel to 280 children.

\$1,250 can provide:

- One month of weekly meals for 80 children at our second Cuba program, Pastor Fiffe's church.
- One month of Pastoring the Lambs -- weekly evangelism and discipleship program with a mealfor 90 children per week

\$2,500 can provide:

A tricycle for Pastor Fiffe's program.

\$15,000 can provide:

- Annual cost for Pastoring the Lambs evangelism and discipleship program for 90 children and employment for 10 leaders.
- Annual cost of weekly meals for 80 children at our second Cuba program, Pastor Fiffe's church.







WHY CUBA

The recent improvement of relations with the U.S. has provided a historic opportunity to support the work of the Church in Cuba which has exploded in recent years. Thirty years ago, 1% of the population attended weekly services, by 2004 that number reached 20%, and the growth since has been described as "miraculous", akin to biblical times; the more resistance God's people faced, the faster the Church grew.
