Opportunity:

Kibibi, Uganda faces deep challenges—poverty, limited education, and few opportunities for youth, leading many to leave their families in search of work. Forward Edge's Light A Candle Uganda (LACU) program has already begun transforming the community with programs like a school feeding initiative, a new kitchen, and a Savings Club. A new Community Center will build on this momentum, offering vocational training, business coaching, and spiritual discipleship to equip youth and strengthen the future of Kibibi.



Kibibi, Uganda is home to a community of 800 people, where 60% live in poverty. Families primarily survive as subsistence farmers, and opportunities for education and future employment are extremely limited. Without access to higher education or vocational training,





many youth leave Kibibi to seek work in Kampala, often losing connection to their families and communities. At the same time, the community faces a critical need for its youth to remain and eventually take over family land to ensure it isn't lost.

Light A Candle Uganda (LACU) is already making a difference in Kibibi. Through their efforts, a school feeding program has been established, and Forward Edge recently built a new kitchen to support it. Additionally, a Savings Club was launched following our community assessment, empowering families to begin saving and planning for their futures.

The next step in transforming Kibibi is the construction of a Community Center. This facility will amplify the impact of existing programs while opening new opportunities for growth and development. The center will include:

- Vocational training to equip youth with practical skills.
- Business coaching to support entrepreneurship and economic development.
- · Savings club expansion to strengthen financial stability.
- Spiritual discipleship and community gatherings in dedicated classroom spaces.

In Phase Two, bedrooms and bathrooms will be added to accommodate Mission Teams and other visitors, further supporting the community's growth and development.
